USING THE GODLY FUND-RAISING CARDS

1. Remember what Godly Fund-Raising is:

- This is an act of praise – telling what God is doing
- You are offering the gift of maturity & blessing
- You are simply being obedient to get what God has already said He would provide
- 89% give to some non-profit each year

2. Use your Success equation:

- **60% Preparation**
 - Pray
 - Become accountable to a partner
 - Make a list
 - Know your mission and develop a story with God's instruction to give
 - Set up a consistent calendar of appointments - at least two per month (ie: the 15th and 30th of every month)
- **10% Presentation**
 - Pray
 - Tell your story (from Preparation)
 - Provide a reason to give and make a specific committal questions (ie: "Will you give a gift of \$_____ to reach more children in the public schools with the Gospel?")
 - If answered, "No", ask, "What could you do at this time?" or "Why?"
 - Present an Action envelope
- **30% Follow up**
 - Follow up with a "Thank You" call or note

- Invite them or even better 'kidnap' them to a ministry event such as a Good News Club (check with your director to coordinate)

3. Keep records

- Keep proficient donor records that can report donors giving habits
- Send out receipting with a story of how their giving has impacted within a week
- Map out a quarterly contact schedule (every donor should receive a personal phone call or visit by a board member)

What NOT To Do With The Cards

- Expect them to do what only your personal relationship can do.
- Use without being a financial partner yourself.
- Use them alone without any personal passion and/or story.
- Add in a mailing. They are tools to help YOU give praise to God for what He is doing and inviting others to grow and be blessed in response to His work!
- Keep them to yourself. Once you've shared – give it away. Let them share it with others!
